Reaching New People in New Ways - Fresh Expressions:

The Budget includes both the costs and the funding from the Church Commissioners for this project aimed at making 8000 new Disciples of Christ through the development of 300 Fresh Expressions of Church and 1200 Lay Leaders by 2028.

The draft budget proposes an increase in parish share of £267K or about 83p per month per electoral roll member.

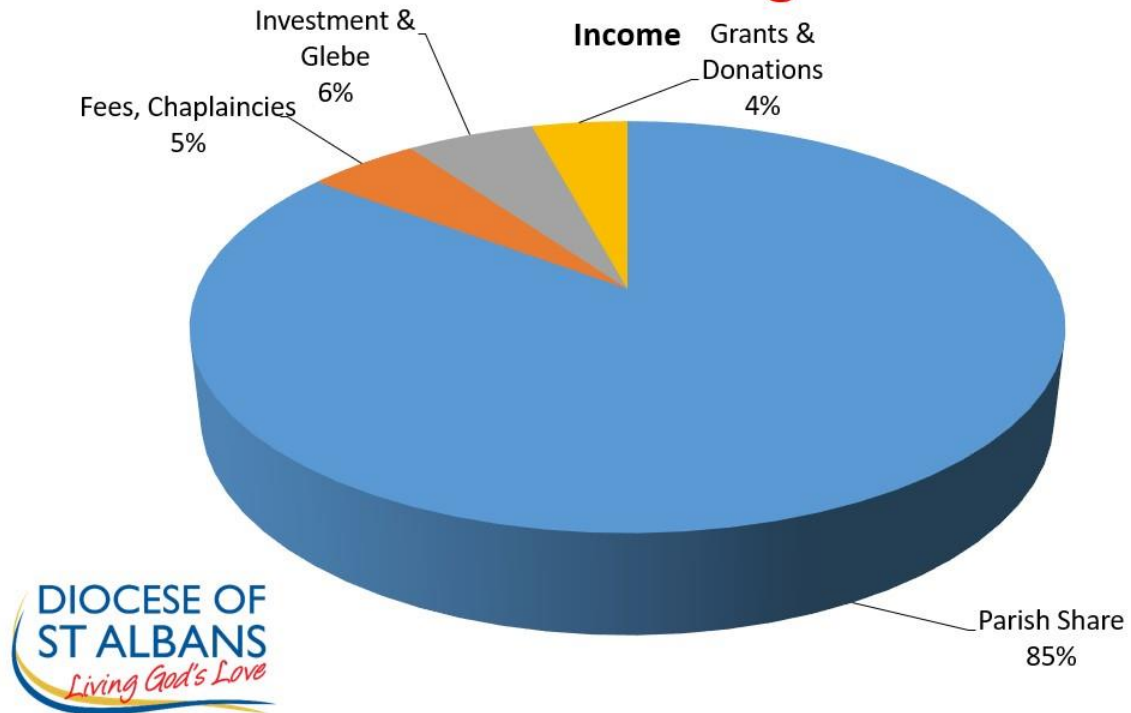

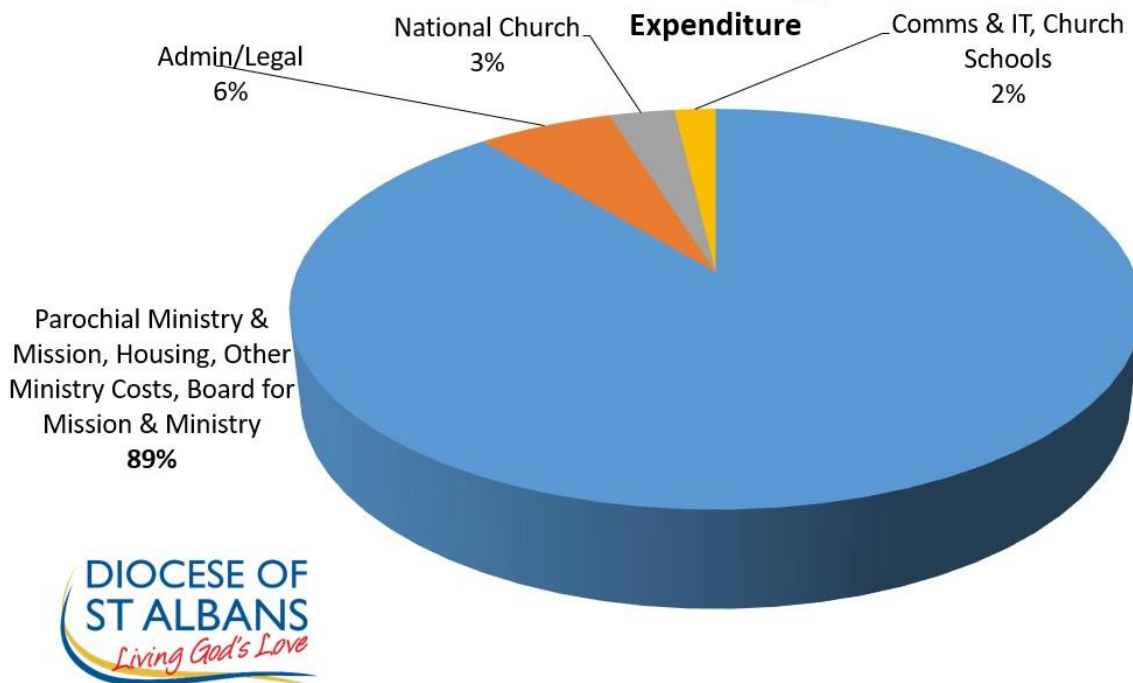
