

GENERAL COMMITTEE

Constituted by Resolution of the Board on 21st October 1952

Terms of reference

To consider and make recommendations to the Board on all matters other than those within the terms of reference of the other committees of the Board, including general administration, finance, pensions, buildings, ecclesiastical and educational trusts; to act as appropriate for the Governing Body under all Schemes made under Section 86 of the Education Act, 1944, Section 2 of the Education Act, 1973 and Section 554 of the Education Act 1996; to deal with the management of redundant churches vested in the Board under the Pastoral Measure 1983; and to administer the Diocesan Church Schools Fund and the Consolidated Fund for Statutory Education. The committee has power to act where, for reasons of urgency, an immediate decision is essential, such actions to be subsequently reported to the Board.
