



Potential sources of funding for toilets and kitchen facilities in churches in Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire

This note flags-up funders more likely to grant-aid new toilet and/or kitchen facilities but others, including more local sources, may be found. More information on most of the funders listed below is given in our advice notes on [national grants](#) and [local grants](#).

It is helpful to view websites and get in touch with funders to discuss your project and its eligibility for their grants at an early stage to establish a connection and avoid wasted work.

Some funders will grant-aid work in Bedfordshire or Hertfordshire but not both.

Funders with some kind of local focus
