

EXAMPLE: CHILDRENS LEAFLET



St xxx is a church that believes in children too!

You are welcome to bring children to all of our services. The one they would probably enjoy most is on Sundays at 9.30am when we have a crèche for babies and toddlers, Junior Church for children and a breakfast group for younger teenagers.

Once a month all the children stay for the whole service, often taking part as readers, servers, by leading the prayers or playing in the orchestra. Children who play an orchestral instrument are welcome to join in.

We always have refreshments after the 9.30am service - there are loos in the church hall basement.

We have a Wednesday morning session for parents/carers and babies. Come and meet other families, play with our toys and have a cup of tea - 11-12 noon in the church. There is also a group for toddlers/parents on Tuesdays between 9.30 and 11am.

If your children enjoy singing and are aged 7+, they can join our choir. We have two choirs - one for girls and boys, and a teenage /adult choir for the 9.30am service and for the traditional services including Choral Evensong,. The choirs rehearse on Thursday evenings from 7.30pm, free musical training, social events and even pay!

SMUG is the church's youth group. They meet after Evensong on Sundays for table tennis, snooker and other activities.

If you would like to bring your babies, children (or even yourself) for baptism, please talk to the Vicar or come to the office on Saturday mornings at 10.30am.
